Environmental Analysis of Community Recreational Facility for Spokane Youth Sports Association. This proposal consists of multi-use sports fields with synthetic turf, off-street parking, lighting, fencing, landscaping, on-site waste disposal, and associated facilities (phased construction).

Purpose of the MDNS Addendum:

This addendum evaluates the proposal by adding additional information to the previous environmental review for the project. The previous review included an Environmental Checklist dated May 13, 2009, and a Mitigated Determination of Nonsignificance (MDNS) issued on October 14, 2009 that was appealed to the Spokane County Hearing Examiner. The Hearing Examiner upheld issuance of the MDNS, subject to additional mitigating measures, on January 8, 2010.

Description of the Proposal:

This proposal of Community Recreational Facility for Spokane Youth Sports Association. This proposal consists of multi-use sports fields with synthetic turf, off-street parking, lighting, fencing, landscaping, on-site waste disposal, and associated facilities (phased construction). ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW

Overview

This addendum does not significantly change the analysis of impacts and alternatives contained in the MDNS prepared in 2009 for the proposal, nor does it identify new or significantly different impacts.

Prior Environmental Review

The county issued a Mitigated Determination of Nonsignificance (MDNS) for the project on October 14, 2009. The prior MDNS was appealed by the Glenrose Community Association. The Spokane County Hearing Examiner, in Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Decision dated January 8, 2010, upheld issuance of the MDNS, subject to additional mitigating measures. The elements of the environment addressed in these documents included elements of both the natural and built environment: earth, air, water, plants and animals, land and shoreline use, transportation, energy, public services, and utilities. The changes in the proposal are within the scope analyzed for the entire project in the environmental checklist and previous MDNS.

Addendum

According to SEPA Rules, an addendum provides additional analysis and/or information about a proposal or alternative where their significant environmental impacts have been disclosed and identified in a previous environmental document (WAC 197-11-706). An Addendum is appropriate when the impacts of the new proposal are the same general types as those identified in the prior document, and when the new analysis does not substantially change the analysis of significant impacts and alternatives identified in the prior environmental documents (WAC 197-11-600(4)(e), WAC 197-11-706.

This addendum is being issued pursuant to WAC 197-11-625 to meet the County's SEPA responsibility and includes use of existing environmental documents per WAC 197-11-600(2), 197-11-600(4)(a)(c), and 197-11-635. The impacts that encompass the project and environmental impacts that are expected to be associated with this project are identified in the Addendum.

No additional impacts beyond those identified in the County's previous environmental determination (MDNS) are expected to occur. Additional information considered with this addendum include an updated Wetland Delineation and Surface Water Evaluation, Traffic Impact Analysis, and Grading Permit dated June 26, 2009. These documents are included as exhibits to the Addendum document for the proposal.

Proposed Action

Community Recreational Facility for Spokane Youth Sports Association as described herein.

Additional Studies Included with the Addendum

An addendum is appropriate when the impacts of the new proposal are the same general types as those identified in the prior document, and when the new analysis does not substantially change the analysis of significant impacts and alternatives identified in the prior environmental documents.

New information and analysis was provided for the proposed project. The new information does not substantially alter the analysis of the previous environmental analysis but provides updated data for consideration. The new information is summarized below.


Conclusion

Previous review included an environmental checklist and a Mitigated Determination of Nonsignificance (MDNS) dated October 14, 2009 and additional mitigating measures specified in the Hearing Examiner's Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Decision dated January 8, 2010.

The previous environmental documents provide relevant information and an accurate basis for identifying potential impacts associated with the project described herein. Potential environmental impacts would be similar to, or less than, those identified in the previous review based on the updated Wetland Delineation, Surface Water Evaluation, and Traffic Impact Analysis.


