Have you heard of the Hirst decision and the furor it is causing across the state as it relates to water wells? Do you know how much water you have in your well or how to maintain your well. Do you have questions? Come to the meeting and get answers. It will be a fascinating meeting on an aspect of rural living that we can't get along without! Watch for more information on the annual meeting as we get nearer to the April 13th.

At the annual meeting we are also going to give away, that's right, <u>its free</u>, a prize valued at \$1000.00. Your Glenrose Firewise Committee has organized a demonstration of proper thinning on a TGA member's treed property. You can enter in the drawing as long as you belong to TGA and you are present at the annual meeting to receive your prize. At the event to be held from 10am-2pm on Saturday, May 13th those in attendance will learn safe work practices with chain saws, loppers, and a tow behind chipper. Attendees will help thin the road accessible property learning how to limb and properly space trees to help prevent wildfire and promote a healthy forest. We will show various ways to disperse slash. Those in attendance will also learn how to apply for DNR grants to thin their property and get a list of contractors they can hire to do the work. The first ten people who attend the event will receive free ear plugs, safety glasses, and work gloves.
