You will recognize his son Alphus Williamson's white barn which still stands on the east side of Glenrose Road and 28th Avenue.

The reason I mention this history is because a common thread with all of us that live here in Glenrose is stewardship. Today we are all privileged to live in Glenrose due to the care and concern of those that came before us. That legacy has been passed on to us and it is our responsibility to care for this area for not only our enjoyment but also for those that follow in our footsteps. 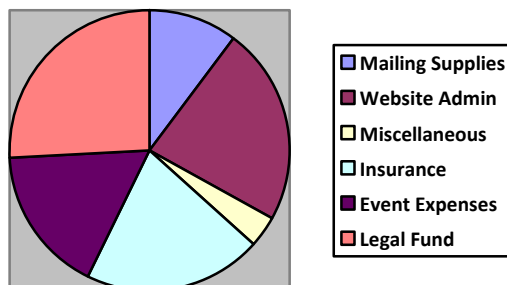
